

Our Impact



REHOPE BY THE NUMBERS 2022

Over the last two years, REHOPE tripled housing capacity for adult survivors from six to eighteen beds and doubled the number of beds for children, adding residential capacity for up to 7 boys to existing 7 bed capacity for girls in a separate home. With the addition of ten Tiny Cottages, REHOPE will double the number of adult beds from 18 to 35.

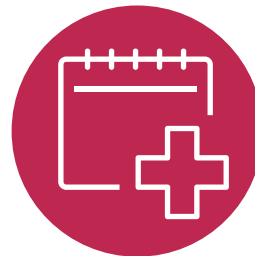

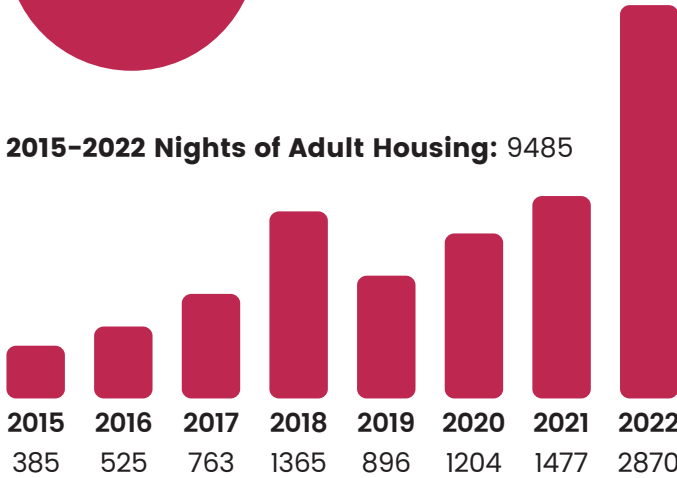
